A Local Law to amend the New York city charter, in relation to requiring each community board to establish a veterans committee

## Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision d of section 2800 of chapter 70 of the New York city charter is amended by

adding a new subparagraph 22 to read as follows:

(22) Establish a committee dedicated to the needs of veterans and their families, with the meetings of

## such committee open to the public except as otherwise provided by law.

§2. This local law takes effect 90 days after it becomes law.
