WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on December 22, 2015 its approval dated December 14, 2015 of the petition of Becaf, LLC, d/b/a Poco NYC, for a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 33 Avenue B, Community District 3, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226 (g) of the Administrative Code;
