By Council Members Dromm, Salamanca, Barron, Cornegy and Rosenthal

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to defining the term reside in the lead law

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 27-2056.2 of the administrative code of the city of New York, as added by local law 1

for the year 2004, is amended by adding a new subdivision (16) to read as follows:

(16) "Reside" or "residency" shall mean being present in a dwelling unit for 15 or more hours in a

typical week.

§ 2. This local law takes effect 180 days after it becomes law, except that the board of health, department of health and mental hygiene, and department of housing preservation and development may take

such actions, including the promulgation of rules, as are necessary for its timely implementation prior to such

effective date.
