WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on March 17, 2017 its approval dated March 15, 2017 of the petition of Coliemore Inc, d/b/a Five Mile Stone, for the renewal of a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 1640 Second Avenue, Community District 8, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
