A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to posting signs informing consumers about co-pay clawbacks for prescription drugs

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subchapter 3 of chapter 5 of title 20 of the administrative code of the city of New York is

amended by adding a new section 20-713.2 to read as follows:

§ 20-713.2 Required signage. Every retail outlet selling prescription drugs within the city must

conspicuously post on or near any fixed point of sale terminal a sign in large font informing customers that

drugs might cost less than an insurance co-payment. The department shall determine the form of such posting.

§ 2. This local law takes effect 120 days after it becomes law except that the department shall take such

measures as are necessary for the implementation of this local law, including the promulgation of rules, before

such date.
