A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the publication of quarterly reports by the New York City Police Department on quality of life summonses issued and graffitirelated arrests made

## Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 1 of title 14 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding a

new section 14-175 to read as follows:

§ 14-175. On a quarterly basis, the department shall publish on its website the following report on

quality of life summonses and graffiti-related arrests: 1) a listing of all of the offenses designated by the

department as quality of life offenses and graffiti-related offenses during the preceding quarter, 2) the total

number of quality of life summonses issued during the quarter, 3) the total number of summonses issued for the

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seven most frequently charged quality of life offenses, disaggregated by charge, and 4) the total number of graffiti-related arrests, disaggregated by charge. Subdivisions 2, 3, and 4 of this section shall be disaggregated by precinct.

§ 2. This local law takes effect 120 days after it becomes law.
