A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to prohibiting New York city from contracting with entities engaged in immigration enforcement

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 1 of Title 6 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding

a new section 6-143 to read as follows:

§6-143 City contracts with entities engaged in immigration enforcement. The city shall not provide a

good or goods, or perform a service or services, in return for a fee or an in kind payment, to entities engaged in

immigration enforcement, as defined in section 10-178.

§2. This local law takes effect 60 days after it becomes law and applies to existing and future contracts.
