A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to protecting the identities of victims of crimes of violence

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 1 of title 14 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding

a new section 14-177 to read as follows:

§ 14-177 Crime victim identity information. a. Upon request of a victim of a crime of violence, the

police department shall not disclose the name of such victim in reports made available to the public in

accordance with Public Officers Law § 87(2).

b. Nothing in this section prohibits the police department from disclosing the name of a victim of a

crime of violence in a criminal or civil court proceeding or when the commissioner has determined that such

disclosure is necessary to protect the public safety.

§ 2. This local law takes effect immediately.
