A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to violations for standing water

## Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 1 of title 17 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding

a new section 17-199.11 to read as follows:

§ 17-199.11 Standing water. When the department has issued a notice of violation and ordered a person

to eliminate standing water, pursuant to section 151.03 of the health code, such person shall have five days to

cure to such violation before any penalty may be imposed or injunctive relief sought to restrain such violation.

The commissioner may promulgate rules as may be necessary for the purpose of carrying out this section.

§ 2. This local law takes effect immediately.
