State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Padavan, S.4258-A, and Committee on Rules, A.8668-A, "AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to the employment of retired New York city police and fire department personnel".

Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Padavan, S.4258-A, and Committee on Rules, A.8668-A, "AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to the employment of retired New York city police and fire department personnel"; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Council of the City of New York, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Article 9 of the Constitution of the State of New York, does hereby request the New York State Legislature to enact into law the aforesaid pending bills.
