Resolution amending Rule 7.50 of the Rules of the Council.

By The Speaker (Council Member Quinn) and Council Members Reyna, Comrie, Fidler, Jackson, Yassky, Brewer, Garodnick, de Blasio, Dickens, Sears, Weprin, Lappin and Liu

Section one. Rule 7.50 of the Rules of the Council shall read as follows:

7.50 Meetings.- d. Committees shall provide reasonable advance notice at least seventy-two hours

where practical of committee meetings to the public. Such notice shall be given to the news media and shall be

posted in a public location at City Hall and the web site.
