State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Padavan, S.3972-A, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.6381-A, "AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to the employment of retired New York city police personnel".

**Whereas**, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Padavan, S.3972-A, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.6381, "AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to the employment of retired New York city police personnel"; and

**Whereas**, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it

**Resolved**, that the Council of the City of New York, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Article 9 of the Constitution of the State of New York, does hereby request the New York State Legislature to enact into law the aforesaid pending bills.
