THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 343

Resolution approving the decision of the City Planning Commission on an application submitted by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development, ULURP No. C 060250 HAX, approving the designation of property located at 1510-1530 Jesup Avenue (Block 2872/Lots 281, 285 and p/o 287), the Bronx, as an Urban Development Action Area, approving the project for the area as an Urban Development Action Area Project, and approving the disposition of such property to a developer selected by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development (L.U. No. 68; C 060250 HAX).

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission filed with the Council on April 28, 2006 its decision dated April 26, 2006 (the "Decision"), on the application submitted by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter and Article 16 of the General Municipal Law of New York State regarding:

- a) the designation of property located at 1510-1530 Jesup Avenue (Block 2872, Lots 281, 285 and p/o 287), as an Urban Development Action Area (the "Area");
- b) an Urban Development Action Area Project for such area (the "Project"); and

pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter for the disposition of such property to a developer

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selected by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development to facilitate development of a six-story building, tentatively known as Jesup Heights Apartments II with approximately 75 residential units developed under the New York State Housing Trust Fund Corporation and the New York City Housing Development Corporation Low Income Housing Tax Credits Program (the "Disposition"), Community District 4, Borough of the Bronx (ULURP No. C 060250 HAX) (the "Application");

WHEREAS, the Decision is subject to review and action by the Council pursuant to Section 197-d(b)(1) of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Application and Decision are subject to review and action by the Council pursuant to Article 16 of the General Municipal Law of New York State;

WHEREAS, the New York City Department of Housing Preservation and Development ("HPD") submitted to the Council its recommendations regarding the Application by submission dated May 3, 2006;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Application and Decision on May 16, 2006;

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the relevant environmental review (CEQR No. 06HPD007X) and the fact that a Negative Declaration was issued on December 5, 2006 and revised on April 18, 2006;

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use and financial implications and other policy issues relating to the Application;

RESOLVED:

The Council finds that the actions described herein will have no significant effect on the environment;

Pursuant to Section 197-d, the Council approves the decision of the City Planning Commission (C 060250 HAX).

The Council finds that the present status of the Disposition Area tends to impair or arrest the sound growth and development of the City of New York and that a designation of the Project as an urban development action area project is consistent with the policy and purposes stated in Section 691 of the General Municipal Law.

The Council approves the designation of the Disposition Area as an urban development action area pursuant to Section 693 of the General Municipal Law.

The Council approves the Project as an urban development action area project pursuant to Section 694 of the General Municipal Law.

The Council approves the disposition of said property to a developer selected by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development;
