WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission filed with the Council on April 28, 2006 its decision dated April 26, 2006 (the "Decision") on the application submitted pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter by the Administration for Children's Services and the Department of Citywide Administrative Services for the acquisition of property located at 783 Knickerbocker Avenue (Block 3413, Lot 6), Community District 4, Borough of Brooklyn (the "Site"), for continued use as a day care center (ULURP No. C 050371 PQK) (the "Application");
