WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on August 7, 2007, a copy of its designation dated July 24, 2007 (the "Designation"), of the Frederick C. and Birdsall Otis Edey Residence located at 10 West 56th Street, Community District 5, Borough of Manhattan, as a landmark and Block 1271, Lot 46, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on September 21, 2007 its report on the Designation dated September 19, 2007 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on October 23, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;
