WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on March 26, 2008 a copy of its designation dated March 18, 2008 (the "Designation"), of the Webster Hall and Annex, located at 119-125 East 11th Street, Community District 3, Borough of Manhattan, as a landmark and Block 556, Lot 68, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on May 12, 2008 its report on the Designation dated May 7, 2008 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on June 2, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council affirms the Designation.
