WHEREAS, the New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation, filed with the Council on May 27, 2008 notice of the Board of Directors authorization dated May 27, 2008 of the leasing agreement of a 5.1 acre parcel of land located on the eastern portion of the Jacobi Medical Center fronting on Eastchester Road to the Albert Einstein College of Medicine, Yeshiva University, to facilitate the construction of housing for the students and limited accessory retail uses, upon the terms and conditions set forth in the Health and Hospitals Corporation resolution authorizing the leasing, a copy of which is attached hereto (the "Leasing"), Community District 11, Borough of the Bronx;

WHEREAS, the Leasing is subject to review and action by the Council pursuant to Section 7385(6) of the Health and Hospitals Corporation Act;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Leasing on June 17, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use and financial implications and other policy issues relating to the Leasing;

RESOLVED:

Leasing upon the terms and conditions set forth in the Board of Directors' resolution authorizing the Leasing, a copy of which is attached hereto.
