WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on November 25, 2008 a copy of its designation dated November 18, 2008 (the "Designation"), of the Red Hook Play Center (Sol Goldman Pool), located at 155 Bay Street, Community District 6, Borough of Brooklyn, as a landmark and Block 582, Lot 1, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on January 9, 2009 its report on the Designation dated January 7, 2009 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on January 26, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;
