WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on December 23, 2008 a copy of its designation dated December 16, 2008 (the "Designation"), of the St. Nicholas of Myra Orthodox Church building, located at 288 East 10<sup>th</sup> Street a.k.a. 155-157 Avenue A, Community District 3, Borough of Manhattan, as an historic landmark and Block 437, Lot 25, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on February 6, 2009 its report on the Designation dated February 4, 2009 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;
