WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on April 1, 2009 a copy of its designation dated March 24, 2009 (the "Designation"), of Jamaica High School located at 167-01 Gothic Drive, Community District 8, Borough of Queens, as a landmark and Tax Map Block 9858, Lot 100, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on June 15, 2009 its report on the Designation dated June 3, 2009 (the "Report");
