A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to prohibiting vending vehicles or pushcarts from being placed over any ventilation grill, cellar door, manhole, transformer vault, or subway access grating.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 17-315 of the administrative code of the city of New York is hereby amended by

adding a new subdivision m, to read as follows:

m. No vending vehicle or pushcart shall be placed over any ventilation grill, cellar door, manhole,

transformer vault, or subway access grating.
