A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring that the affidavits required for the filing of a real property transfer tax return on the sale of one- or two- family dwellings as well as cooperative and condominium apartments indicate that the premises sold is equipped with an operational carbon monoxide detecting device as well as a smoke detecting device.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision g of section 11-2105 of the administrative code of the city of New York is re-

lettered as subdivision h and as re-lettered is amended to read as follows:

h. Returns with respect to the conveyance of a one- or two-family dwelling, an

individual residential condominium unit and the shares of stock allocable to an individual cooperative

<u>apartment</u> will not be accepted for filing unless accompanied by [an affidavit] <u>affidavits</u> signed by the grantor and grantee <u>and by any person who has appraised the dwelling, at the time of the inspection of the</u> <u>condominium unit or cooperative apartment to establish its value,</u> indicating that the premises is equipped with [an] approved and operational smoke <u>and carbon monoxide</u> detecting [device] <u>devices</u> as provided in [article] <u>articles</u> six <u>and seven</u> of subchapter seventeen of chapter one of title twenty-seven of this code.

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately upon enactment.
