WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on June 24, 2009 its approval dated June 24, 2009 of the petition of Lucky 13, LLC, d/b/a Gin Lane, for a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 355 West 14<sup>th</sup> Street, Community District 4, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
