WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on January 21, 2010 a copy of its designation dated January 12, 2010 (the "Designation"), of the Ridgewood Theater Building, located at 55-27 Myrtle Avenue, Community District 5, Borough of Queens, as a landmark and Tax Map (Tax Map Block 3451, part of Lot 7), as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on March 12, 2010 its report on the Designation dated March 10, 2010 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on April 7, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

RESOLVED:
