WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on July 12, 2010 its approval dated July 9, 2010 of the petition of Watawa, Inc., d/b/a Watawa, for a revocable consent to modify, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 33-10 Ditmars Boulevard, Community District 1, Borough of Queens (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
