State Legislation Resolution No. 77

State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Maltese, S.5598-A, and Assembly Member Cusick, A.8326-A, “AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the establishment of a twenty-five/age fifty retirement program for members of the New York city employees’ retirement system of New York city board of education retirement system employed in stock worker supervisor positions; and in relation to providing for employer pick up, pursuant to provisions of the internal revenue code, of certain additional member contributions required to be made by certain participants in the twenty-five year/age fifty retirement program”.

Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Maltese, S.5598-A, and Assembly Member Cusick, A.8326-A, “AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the establishment of a twenty-five year/age fifty retirement program for members of the New York city employees’ retirement system or New York city board of education retirement system employed in stock worker supervisor positions; and in relation to providing for employer pick up, pursuant to provisions of the internal revenue code, of certain additional member contributions required to be made by certain participants in twenty-five year/age fifty retirement program”; and

Resolved, that the Council of the City of New York, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Article 9 of the Constitution of the State of New York, does hereby request the New York State Legislature to enact into law the aforesaid pending bills.
