## THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 1492

Resolution affirming the designation by the Landmarks Preservation Commission of the (Former) Congregation Beth Hamedrash Hagadol Anshe Ungurn, located at 242 East 7<sup>th</sup> Street (Block 376/Lot 13), Borough of Manhattan, Designation List No. 397, LP-2261 (L.U. No. 795, 20085445 HKM (N 080348 HKM).

WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on March 26, 2008 a copy of its designation dated March 18, 2008 (the "Designation"), of the (Former) Congregation Beth Hamedrash Hagadol Anshe Ungurn, located at 242 East 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Community District 3, Borough of Manhattan, as a landmark and Block 376, Lot 13, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on May 12, 2008 its report on the Designation dated May 7, 2008 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on June 2, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

RESOLVED:

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council affirms the Designation.
