State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Lanza, S.7024-B, and Assembly Members Cusick, Eddington, Wright, Kellner, Peralta, *et al*, A.10119-C, “AN ACT to amend the general business law and the executive law, in relation to the licensing of security guards and the business of watch, guard or patrol agency and the registry thereof”.

**Whereas**, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Lanza, S.7024-B, and Assembly Members Cusick, Eddington, Wright, Kellner, Peralta, *et al*, A.10119-C, “AN ACT to amend the general business law and the executive law, in relation to the licensing of security guards and the business of watch, guard or patrol agency and the registry thereof”; and

**Whereas**, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it
