**A LOCAL LAW**

**In relation to a street name, Bainbridge Avenue-Mt. St. Ursula Place, Borough of The Bronx.  
*Be it enacted by the Council as follows:***

**Section one.** The following street name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Bainbridge Avenue- Mt. St. Ursula Place	Bainbridge Avenue	from East 198th Street to Bedford Park Boulevard

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
