**A LOCAL LAW**

**In relation to a street name, Leroy H. Gwirtzman Triangle, Borough of Queens.**

*Be it enacted by the Council as follows:*

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Leroy H. Gwirtzman Triangle	None	bounded by Beach Channel Drive between Beach 144th Street and Beach 145th Street, Beach 144th Street between Beach Channel Drive and Cronston Avenue between Beach 144th Street and Beach 145th Street and Beach 145th Street between Cronston Avenue and Beach Channel Drive

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
