**A LOCAL LAW**

**In relation to a playground name, Judge Seabury Playground, Borough of Manhattan.**

*Be it enacted by the Council as follows:*

Section one. The following playground name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Judge Seabury Playground	(none)	an existing playground located on the east side of Lexington Avenue between East 95th and East 96th Streets.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
