A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, FF Peter F. McLaughlin Way, Borough of Queens.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New Name	Present Name	Limits
FF Peter F. McLaughlin Way	Queens Boulevard	the south side of Queens Boulevard between 64th Street and 65th Street

§2. The provisions of section one of this local law shall not amend the provisions of local law number 53 for the year 1992 in any way nor do they authorize the removal of any sign indicating a street name designation which has been placed pursuant to such local law.

§3. This local law shall take effect immediately.
