A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Little Brazil Street, Borough of Manhattan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

<u>New Name</u>	<u>Present Name</u>	<u>Limits</u>
Little Brazil Street	West 46th Street	between 5th Avenue and Broadway

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
