meeting, LU 414, for the 2149-2153 Pacific street,
Article XI, request by HPD.

Today, we will vote on two applications
by the Department of Parks and Recreation, together
with DCAS, seeking approval of City acquisition and
site selection of a privately owned properties for
future park development. These proposals will create
new parkland to increase access to open space
resources in underserved areas. First, we will vote
to approve LU 420 in Brooklyn Community District 5.
This is a proposal in Council Member Nurse's and
Banks' Districts in Brooklyn. And we will also vote
to approve LU 421 in Queens Community District 3.
This is a proposal in Council Members Cabán's,
Krishnan's, and Moya's Districts in Queens.

Members of the Subcommittee who have any
questions or remarks about today's items, please let
me know.

Seeing none, with the support of local
Members for each project, I will now call for a vote
to approve LU 420 for Brooklyn CD5 Walk-to-Park site
selection, LU 421 for the Queens CD3 Walk-to-Park
selection.
