Introduced by Council Member Berman (by the request of the Mayor).

A LOCAL LAW

To amend the administrative code of the City of New York, in relation to increasing fees payable to the city register and the county clerk of Richmond county for recording certain instruments.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 7-614 of the administrative code of the city of New York, as amended by chapter 78 of the laws of 1989, is amended to read as follows:

1. For recording, indexing and endorsing a certificate on any instrument, ten dollars; and, in addition thereto, two dollars for each page or portion of a page, two dollars for each additional block indexed against exceeding one, and [one dollar] *three dollars* for each additional lot indexed against exceeding one; and, in addition thereto, five dollars for recording any instrument required by state statute to be recorded.

§ 2. This local law shall take effect on September 1, 1991 and shall apply to instruments recorded on or after such date.
