**A LOCAL LAW**

**In relation to a street name, Alfred Ronaldson Place, Borough of the Bronx.**

*Be it enacted by the Council as follows:*

**Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.**

<b>New Name</b>	<b>Present Name</b>	<b>Limits</b>
<b>Alfred Ronaldson Place</b>	<b>East 176th Street</b>	<b>between Third Avenue and Park Avenue</b>

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
