A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a playground name, Virginia T. Flanagan Playground, Borough of Brooklyn.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section one. The following playground name is hereby indicated

New name	Present name	Limits
Virginia T. Flanagan Playground	(none)	an existing playground beginning at a point approximately 250 feet north of Avenue T, on the east side of East 71st Street. The Playground is rectangular in shape and adjacent to the rear of the existing school, running northerly 155 feet along the east side of East 71st Street, turning 90 degrees easterly 252 feet.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
