PROPOSED INTRO. NO: 396-A

COMMITTEE: Civil Rights

TITLE: To amend the administrative code of the City of New York, in relation to the powers and duties of the Commission on Human Rights.
SPONSORS: Rose, Chin, Dromm, Foster, James, Palma, Van Bramer, Williams, Rodriguez, Gennaro, Lappin, and Garodnick

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION: This legislation would require the Commission of Human Rights to submit an annual report to the Mayor and the City Council, which shall be published in the City Record. The annual report shall include information for the calendar year that is the subject of the report, regarding inquiries received by the Commission from the public, complaints filed with the Commission, and education and outreach efforts made by the Commission.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This legislation shall take effect immediately.
