A LOCAL LAW

d 847

To amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to imposing a fee for the issuance of tax clearance certificates by the commissioner of finance.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision a of section 17-310 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended to read as follows:

- a. An application for renewal of a license or permit shall be filed with the appropriate fee for ich renewal, with a tax clearance certificate issued by the state tax commission of the state of ew York, and with a tax clearance certificate issued by the commissioner of finance, in such form and containing such information as he or she shall require, indicating payment of all applicable taxes imposed by title eleven of the code and administered by the commissioner of finance, at least thirty days prior to the expiration date of the existing license or permit. The commissioner of finance shall charge and collect a fee of ten dollars for issuing a tax clearance certificate.
  - §2. Subdivision a of section 20-457 of such code is amended to read as follows:
- a. An application for the renewal of a license shall be filed with the appropriate fee, with a tax clearance certificate issued by the state tax commission of the state of New York, and with a tax clearance certificate issued by the commissioner of finance of the city of New York, in such form and containing such information as he or she shall require, indicating payment of all applicable taxes imposed by title eleven of this code and administered by the commissioner of finance, at releast thirty days prior to the expiration of the existing license. The commissioner of finance shall charge and collect a fee of ten dollars for issuing a tax clearance certificate.
- §3. This local law shall take effect immediately and shall apply to tax clearance certificates issued on or after July first, nineteen hundred and eighty-seven.
