A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a triangle name, S.S.G. Patbouvier E. "Bobby" Ortiz Triangle, Borough of Queens.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following triangle name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
S.S.G. Patbouvier E. "Bobby" Ortiz Triangle	(None)	a triangle located on the east side of 129th Street at the intersection of Metropolitan Avenue and Hillside Avenue.

§ 2. This local law take effect immediately.
