A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Leon Davis Street, Borough of Manhattan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following Street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New Name	Present Name	Limits
Leon Davis Street	West 43rd Street	West 43rd Street from Eighth Avenue to Ninth Avenue

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
