items to be considered on the calendar; Land Use
number 654, a sidewalk café called Dos Toros
Taqueria, item number 20125522 TCM in the
Speaker's district, Manhattan Community Board 12.
It's to establish a sidewalk café at 11 Carmine
Street. We are disapproving the item that we just
heard in the Subcommittee. Land Use number 655 in
Council District 39, Council Member Lander,
Brooklyn Community Board 6, item number 20125549
TCK to revoke the permission to operate an
unenclosed sidewalk café at 320 Court Street.
We're voting to approve Land Use number 656, a

sidewalk café restaurant Doyle's Corner, Council
Member Van Bramer's district, Community Board 1 in
Queens, item number 20125699 TCQ to operate a
sidewalk café at 4202 Broadway. Land Use number
661 in the Speaker's district again, Manhattan
Community Board 2, known as Groove, item number
20125689 TCM to continue to maintain a sidewalk
café at 125 MacDougal Street. Again in the
Speaker's district, Land Use item number 662,
Yerba Buena, in Manhattan Board 2, item number
20125742 TCM, to continue to operate a sidewalk
café at 57 Greenwich Avenue. Another sidewalk
café in Councilman Van Bramer's district, Queens
Community Board 2-sorry, it's another item in
Council Member Van Bramer's district, pre-
considered Land Use item number is PS339 Queens,
item number 20125427 SCQ. It's the site selection
for a new 440 seat primary school facility to be
located at 5702 to 5708 39^{th} Avenue and 3912 to
3916 58 th Street to be within Community School
District 30. The next item is a school to be
located within my council district, Queens
Community Board 12, item number 20125428 SCQ would
be known as PS892 Queens site selection for

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a new approximately 379 seat primary school

659, 120 East 125 th Street Firehouse in Manhattan

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Community Board 11, item number N120248 HAM in
Council Member Viverito's district. It is to
facilitate the rehabilitation of that vacant four
story building per reuse as a visual arts and
resource center for the Caribbean Cultural Center.
We have Land Use number 660, the Midtown West EMS
Station in the Speaker's district, Manhattan
Community Board 4, item number C120177 PCM. It's
for the acquisition of property located at 512
West 23 rd Street for use as an ambulance station.
It's the site selection and reacquisition of
property for use as an ambulance bay station.
