3 welcome to the hearing on the Subcommittee on Public  
4 Sitings and Dispositions. At this time, please

8 CHAIRPERSON HANKS: Good afternoon.  
9 Welcome to the meeting of Subcommittee on Landmarks,  
10 Public Sitings, and Dispositions. I am Council  
11 Member Kamillah Hanks and I'm the Chair of the  
12 Subcommittee. I am joined today by my colleagues  
13 Council Members Brannan, Farias, Marte, and Salaam is  
14 joining us online. Before we begin today's agenda,  
15 I'll remind everyone that this meeting is being held  
16 in a hybrid format. This is a government proceeding  
17 and decorum will and shall be observed at all times.  
18 Now turning to our vote. We will vote to approve LU  
19 98 for the landmark designation of the Old Croton  
20 Aqueduct Walk in Council Member Sanchez's district in  
21 the Bronx. We will also vote to approve LUs 99 and  
22 100 for a proposal by the New York City Department of  
23 Housing, Preservation and Development, including the  
24 designation of an urban-- excuse me-- an urban  
25 development action area, approval of an urban

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2 development action area project, approval of an  
3 Article 11 Real Property Tax Exemption, approval of  
4 an urban development action area project, real  
5 property tax exemption, and the disposition of city-  
6 owned land which together would facilitate the  
7 development of the affordable home ownership project  
8 collectively known as the Resilient Homes Staten  
9 Island Project in Council Member Carr's district in  
10 District 50. Members of the Subcommittee, you have  
11 questions or remarks about today's items, please let  
12 me know. Seeing none, I will now call for the vote  
13 with the support of local Council Members to approve  
14 LU 98, 99, and 100. Counsel, please call the roll.

15 COMMITTEE COUNSEL: Chair Hanks?

16 CHAIRPERSON HANKS: I vote aye.

17 COMMITTEE COUNSEL: Brannan?

18 COUNCIL MEMBER BRANNAN: Aye.

19 COMMITTEE COUNSEL: Council Member  
20 Farías?

21 COUNCIL MEMBER FARÍAS: I vote aye.

22 COMMITTEE COUNSEL: Council Member Marte?

23 COUNCIL MEMBER MARTE: Aye.

24 COMMITTEE COUNSEL: And Council Member  
25 Salaam?

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2 COUNCIL MEMBER SALAAM: I vote aye.

3 CHAIRPERSON HANKS: Thank you, Counsel.

4 Do we need to leave the vote open for any  
5 Subcommittee members who may join us later?

6 COMMITTEE COUNSEL: So, with a vote of 5  
7 in the affirmative, 0 in the negative and 0  
8 abstentions. The items are adopted and referred to  
9 the full Land Use Committee.

10 CHAIRPERSON HANKS: Thank you, Counsel.  
11 That concludes today's business. I would like to  
12 thank the members of the public, my colleagues,  
13 Subcommittee Counsel, Land Use staff and the Sergeant  
14 at Arms for your participation today. This meeting
