A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Cathedral Place - Father James F. Hinchey C.O. Place, Borough of Brooklyn.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section one. The following street name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Cathedral Place - Father James F. Hinchey C.O. Place	Cathedral Place	from Jay Street to Flatbush Avenue Extension

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
