A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a square name, John McKean Square, Borough of Manhattan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following square name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

<u>New Name</u>	<u>Present Name</u>	<u>Limits</u>
John McKean Square	(None)	the intersection of East 43rd Street and Tudor City Place

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
