

This bill establishes a clear mechanism requiring Sanitation to act when a pattern of complaints emerges; that is, when three or more complaints are received about the same city block within a seven-day period. Upon reaching that threshold, Sanitation will be obligated to either directly remove the waste or engage responsible property owners, issuing notices of violation to those who fail to comply. This bill creates a structured, community-driven process that empowers people to report problems while guaranteeing government response.
