- Int 0464-2014** A Local Law to amend the New York city charter, in relation to the department of correction promoting absentee voting among jailed individuals  
*Proposed Int. No. 464-A*
- Int 0508-2014** A Local Law to amend the New York city charter, in relation to allowing online voter registration.

- Res 0232-2014** Resolution calling upon the New York State Legislature to pass, and the Governor to sign into law, A.9108 and S.6452-A, which would amend the election law to consolidate New York's federal, state, and local primaries into one primary which would take place on the fourth Tuesday of June.

- Res 0281-2014** Resolution calling upon the Mayor of the City of New York to create an annual Student Voter Registration Day.

**Res 0695-2015** Resolution calling upon the New York State Legislature to pass, and the Governor to sign, A2529/S857, allowing 16 and 17 year-olds to pre-register to vote.

**Res 0870-2015** Resolution calling on the New York State Legislature to pass and the Governor to sign A.7634, which would amend both the New York State Election Law and the Correction Law, in relation to voting by convicted felons.
