3 CHAIRPERSON VACCA: Joe Borelli, how are
4 you? You're on time. Okay, thank you everyone.

5 [gavel] Good afternoon. My name is James Vacca, and
6 I'm Chair of the Committee on Technology, and today
7 we're here to vote on two pieces of legislation in
8 relation to the accessibility of our city's websites
9 to persons with disabilities, and to those who are
10 limited English proficient. My colleagues are here
11 with me today, Council Member Joseph Borelli, Council
12 Member Barry Grodenchik, and we're also joined by
13 Council Member Jumaane Williams sponsors of one--
14 sponsor of one of the bills, 673-A, which would
15 require every city agency website to provide a
16 translation feature. I also want to thank Council
17 Member Garodnick for introducing legislation dealing
18 with those with disabilities. Since this committee's
19 hearing on both of these bills was completed last
20 spring, we worked with the Administration to tighten
21 up language, and it's been encouraging to see the
22 commitment that everyone across the board has had to
23 making these bills a reality. I want to thank the
24 Speaker, of course, and let me first call upon
25 Council Member Williams, sponsor of Intro 673-A.

2 COUNCIL MEMBER WILLIAMS: Thank you, Mr.
3 Chair and thank you for your support and leadership
4 on this, and obviously we want to thank the Speaker
5 as well and thank you the Administration for working
6 with us to tighten the language, and making something
7 that they can agree with. To me it's kind of a no-
8 brainer. There's already laws that require things to
9 be translated in specific languages. It makes sense
10 that our website should adhere to that law as well.
11 I think as people are going to get information, they
12 should try to get it in a language they understand so
13 they can fully understand how our city operates.
14 This just seemed to be a common sense button that is
15 going to rotate. So we have at least seven major
16 languages. So people can see theirs and just
17 translate it. It seemed like a simple solution that
18 will help a lot of people. So thank you so much for
19 having this hearing, and this vote today.

20 CHAIRPERSON VACCA: Thank you. Council
21 Member Garodnick is not here, but I know I can speak
22 on his behalf in saying that this legislation is
23 important, and the committee passing it today will be
24 significant and we await that action. So why don't I
25 do this, we have our--our--Billy Martin is here who

9 like to ask you to please call the roll. The
10 Chairman asked that there be a yes both on both
11 intros.

12 CLERK: William Martin, Committee Clerk.

14 coupled. Chair Vacca.

15 CHAIRPERSON VACCA: Chair Vacca votes aye
16 on all.

17 CLERK: Grodenchik.

18 COUNCIL MEMBER GRODENCHIK: [off mic] Aye
19 on both.

20 CLERK: Borelli.

21 COUNCIL MEMBER BORELLI: Aye.

22 CLERK: By a vote of 3 in the
23 affirmative, 0 in the negative and no abstentions,
24 both items have been adopted.
