T2009-1757 Oversight: Executive Order 127 of 2009 – Ensuring that New York City’s Hard to Count Populations Are Identified and Encouraged to Participate in the 2010 Census.

Res 0190-2006 Resolution calling on the New York State Legislature to amend the Election Law so that prisoners are counted as residents of the county in which they reside prior to incarceration, rather than as residents of the county in which they are detained.

Proposed Res. No. 190-A

T2009-1758 Resolution calling upon the United States Census Bureau to enforce a decennial census enumeration policy in which incarcerated juveniles and adults are counted in keeping with the “one person, one vote” principle inherent in the Fourteenth Amendment of the Constitution, to insure that resources for the general welfare of all citizens are equitably and appropriately distributed.
