A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a square name, Margaret Sanger Square, Borough of Manhattan

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following square name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New Name	Present name	Limits
Margaret Sanger Square	(None)	the intersection of Bleecker Street and Mott Street

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
